### MARKING SHIP'S PLANS, MANUALS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS WITH IMO SHIP IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

1. As mandated by MSC/Circular.1142, all plans, manuals and other documents required by the various IMO conventions to be carried onboard ships **constructed on or after 1 July 2005** should be marked with the IMO ship identification number in a clearly legible and unambiguous way.
2. Kindly relay this reminder to the ship owners and managers under your respective purview.

## **Annex - Marking the Ship's Plans, Manuals and other Documents with the IMO Ship Identification Number**

1. A large number of plans, manuals and other documents are required to be carried on board ships.
2. The IMO Ship Identification Number Scheme adopted by the Organization by resolution A.600(15) has been made mandatory through SOLAS regulation XI-1/3.
3. All plans, manuals and other documents required by the various IMO conventions to be carried on board ships constructed on or after 1 July 2005 should be marked with the IMO ship identification number in a clearly legible and unambiguous manner.
4. The originator of such plans, manuals and other documents should ensure that the IMO ship identification number is marked on them prior to submission for approval by an Administration or a recognized organization acting on its behalf.
