MARPOL Annex I & V SPECIAL AREAS – RED SEA & GULF OF ADEN

(ISC Circular No.9.R0)

Notice

Attention to all Ship Owners / Managers / Operators / Auditors / Surveyors / DPAs /Ship's Masters

Purpose

This Circular is issued to advise that under IMO Resolutions MEPC.381(80) & MEPC.382(80), new restrictions will apply from 1 January 2025 concerning the discharge of garbage, oil, and oily mixtures in the Special Areas of the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden.

Contents

The following requirements shall apply:

MEPC.381(80) – Regulations 15.3, 15.5 and 34.3 to 34.5 of MARPOL Annex I:

All ships:

On or after 1 January 2025, any discharge into the sea of oil or oily mixtures from ship of 400 gross tonnage and above shall be prohibited within the Red Sea and Gulf of Aden Special Areas, except when all the following conditions are met:

- 1. The ship is proceeding en route;
- 2. The oily mixture is processed through an oil filtering equipment (Oily Water Separator) meeting the requirements of Regulation 14.7 of Annex I;
- 3. The oil content of the effluent without dilution does not exceed 15 parts per million (Oil Content Meter).

Oil tankers:

Any discharge into the sea of oil or oily mixture from the cargo area is already prohibited in Special Areas, even with the ship en route and the effluent processed through the ODME. On or after 1 January 2025, the Red Sea and the Gulf of Aden will be included in the Special Areas.

MEPC.382(80) – Regulation 6 of MARPOL Annex V:

On or after 1 January 2025, discharge of garbage into the sea within the Red Sea Special Area shall only be permitted while the ship is proceeding en route and as prescribed by Regulation 6 (Discharge of garbage within special areas of MARPOL Annex V.
